THE STORY

Set in an imaginary tiger kingdom, Tiger Roar is a short story designed to introduce young children to the important principles related to the Covid-19 pandemic, covering topics such as viruses, vaccines, and immunity, all in a non-culturally specific way. The author, Hannah Jusu-Sheriff, had set a goal with her publishing agency to distribute the book freely to 11,000 schools in Sierra Leone, so she was in need of some marketing and fundraising assistance.
