

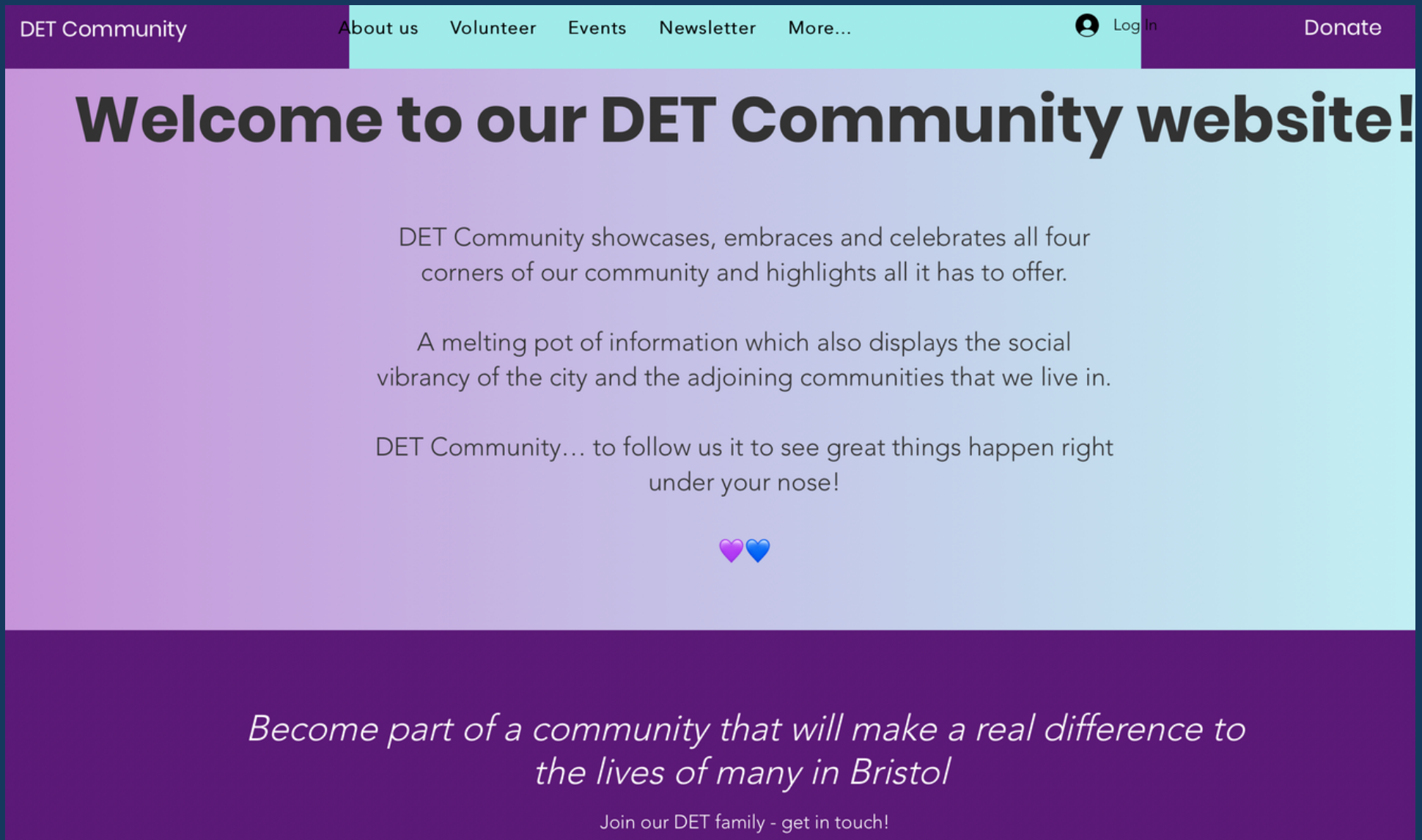
180 DEGREES CONSULTING ADVISE DET ENTERTAINMENT ON HOW TO AMPLIFY THEIR ONLINE PRESENCE
