Freestyle receives referrals through the Grassroots Activators Programme, which is designed to provide 16-25 year-olds from marginalised parts of Bristol with access to role models and pathways to future opportunities. Thanks to a donation from a family charity trust, Freestyle were able to add a new camera gimbal stabiliser to the toolbox of their studio, which is giving the young producers hands on experience with new equipment.
